
ORDER MANDATING ELECTRONIC FILING IN CIVIL CASES

Pursuant to the Uniform Rules of Superior and State Court and the authority given to the courts under O.C.G.A. § 15-6-11(b)(3)(B) and O.C.G.A. § 15-7-5(b)(3)(B), respectively, to advance the effective date of the mandatory electronic filing provisions codified in O.C.G.A. §§ 15-6-11 and 15-7-5, it is hereby ordered that on and after September 1, 2018, all pleadings and any other document related thereto filed by an attorney or non-attorney to initiate a civil action, or in a civil action initiated on or after September 1, 2018, in the Superior or State Courts of the Dougherty Judicial Circuit, shall be filed by electronic means through the court's electronic filing service provider in accordance with the rules governing electronic filing under O.C.G.A. §§ 15-6-11 and 15-7-5.




