FILING IN CIVIL CASES



Pursuant to this Court's authority under O.C.G.A. § 15-6-11(b)(3)(B) to establish the effective date of the mandatory electronic filing provisions codified in O.C.G.A. § 15-6-11, the Superior Court of Richmond County, hereby orders that on and after September 1, 2018, all pleadings and any other documents related thereto filed by an attorney to initiate a civil action or in a civil case in the Superior Court of Richmond County shall be filed by electronic means through the court's electronic filing service provider in accordance with the rules governing electronic filing under O.C.G.A. § 15-6-11.

The Court hereby recognizes that diligent efforts must be made by all concerned, including the Clerk of the Superior Court of Richmond County, to facilitate the transition from voluntary electronic filing to mandatory electronic filing in civil cases. The Clerk of the Superior Court of Richmond County will conduct an electronic filing training session on June 7, 2018, at 2:00 P.M. in Courtroom 3E of the Augusta-Richmond County Judicial Center/John H. Ruffin, Jr. Courthouse. All attorneys of the Augusta Judicial Circuit, and all other attorneys and *pro se* litigants, who may file pleadings or other documents in civil cases in the Superior Court of

Richmond County, are hereby strongly encouraged to attend this training session.
